WASTE MANAGEMENT MAKES CLEAN UP EASY AND FREE WITH OUR BULKY ITEM PICKUP PROGRAM!

Moreno Valley customers receive weekly curbside BULKY ITEM pickups for each residence at no additional expense. Bulky item collections take place on the customer's regularly scheduled collection day by appointment made with Waste Management.

BULKY ITEMS include: discarded furniture (including chairs, sofas, mattresses and rugs); appliances (including refrigerators with freon, ranges, washers, dryers, water-



heaters, dish washers, air conditioner units with CFC's, televisions, electronic appliances, small household appliances and other similar items commonly known as "white goods", waste tires (up to four (4) per individual request), and oversized yard waste such as tree trunks and large branches – if no longer than two (2) feet in diameter and four (4) feet in length and similar large items.

Items not accepted as **BULKY WASTE** are large items such as car bodies, camper shells, mobile homes, trailers, jacuzzi tubs or spas, or any other items that cannot be safely lifted and collected by one (1) person. In addition, **BULKY WASTE** does not include any hazardous waste (batteries, paints, oils, solvents, cleaners, gasoline, etc.), special waste or items that in the future may be banned by regulation.

Here are some important guidelines to follow:

- Call Waste Management's service center at **(800) 423-9986, no later than 48 hours** before your regularly scheduled trash and recycling collection day.
- Describe to the Waste Management Agent what items need to be collected so that your bulky collection will be properly routed.
- Place bulky items at curbside adjacent to your trash and recycling carts before 6:00 a.m. on your regular collection day. *Please note that a different Waste Management truck may collect bulky items and not be your regular Waste Management Driver.*

IMPORTANT: If bulky items are **not scheduled** for pick up on your regularly scheduled collection day, or placed out 24 hours prior to your bulky item appointment on your regular trash and recycling collection day, it will be considered illegally dumped and the property owner will be subject to a citation by Code Enforcement.

Bulky Item Pick-up Just a Phone Call Away!

Bulky item collection of large household items, appliances, furniture or multiple smaller items is available for City of Moreno Valley residents at no charge.

Examples of acceptable items include:

Electronic waste, tires, furniture, mattresses, appliances, lumber (cut into 4-foot pieces and bundled), oversized household solid waste, refrigerators* and air conditioners*.

To schedule the pick-up of large items, call the Waste Management customer service center at 800-423-9986 at least 48 hours prior to your regular collection day.

Don't leave leaves behind this fall!



Place them inside your green waste cart to be composted! Other green waste you can put inside your green waste cart includes: Grass , Clippings, Sticks, Small Branches, Wood (untreated, not painted) and Tree Trimmings. No plastic bags (plastic bags can be recycled at your local retail grocer).



Waste Management Observes the following holidays:
